Carol is of Wathaurung (Victoria) and Scottish descent. Through her artistic practice, she explores this rich cultural identity of diverse ancestry and lived experience.

Stephen hand-painted garments and accessories for Easton Pearson, created embroidery and beading patterns, designed window displays, shop fittings and runway shows. He has also created the 'Moki Room' in *The Designers' Guide: Easton Pearson Archive*, a fun space showcasing the
